Sermon Discussion Questions | Romans 14:13-23

- 1. Can you think of an example of the kind of division that Paul is talking about here, where a cultural value is elevated to a spiritual value? Have you ever had the chance to welcome or be welcomed by Christians on the other side of such a disagreement?
- 2. How is *welcoming* someone with whom you disagree different from mere tolerance?
- 3. Why does Paul see such high stakes in this matter (v. 15, "...do not destroy the one for whom Christ died," v. 20, "Do not... destroy the work of God.")? How do we understand "destroy" alongside of the assurance of ch. 8 (e.g. vv. 38-39)?
- 4. Read Paul's description of the kingdom of God (v. 17).
 - a. How should this affect the way we think about *service* in the church? (v. 18)
 - b. How does it help define "what makes for peace and for mutual upbuilding"? (v. 19)
- 5. How do we see Jesus embodying all that Paul commends here so that we might derive hope from our union with him?
- 6. Spend some time praying for the work of God in the church –righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit.
