**Sermon Discussion Questions | [Romans 16:17-23](#)**

1. What are some doctrines that obstruct or divide that Paul alludes to elsewhere in Romans? What false doctrines lure your own heart at times?
2. What would it look like practically to “be wise as to what is good and innocent to what is evil” in our culture today?
3. How (if at all) does belief in the work of Satan and demonic forces show up in normal Christian life? How should the promise of Satan’s destruction help us to persevere in the Christian life as it relates to the themes of this passage?
4. Pray that the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your Community Group, Christ the King Church, and Christians across the world.
