## Sermon Discussion Questions |Romans 16:1-16

1. What does this passage teach us about Paul's own person and ministry?
2. What are you saying when you confess "one holy, catholic, and apostolic church"? (Note: catholic literally means "of the whole.") How is that an encouragement - to you personally or to our church, located in such a transient city?
3. What are some of the gifts that you see in your community group that can be of service to our church and our city?
4. What is the significance of Paul's repeated use of the phrase "in Christ" as he goes through this list of greetings?
5. Why do you think Paul ends this letter with an emphasis on unity among the diverse members of the church? How does it all flow from the peace with God he speaks of in $5: 1$ ?
6. Spend some time in prayer giving thanks, in specific ways if you can, for the members of Christ the King - our small part of this "one body in Christ, and individually members one of another." (Rom. 12:5)
